To: The Idaho Legislature and the Citizens of Idaho

Re: The Prosecution of Child Sexual Abuse

With this letter, we submit the annual report for fiscal 2017 on the prosecution of child sexual abuse in Idaho. Sadly, in fiscal 2017, the total number of reported incidents of child sexual abuse increased dramatically, reaching the highest level since fiscal 2014, and the second-highest level since this report was instituted in 2006.

This illustrates the intractable nature of this problem and the need for parents, family members, teachers and others to be ever vigilant in protecting our children from sexual abuse. This vigilance includes protecting children from potentially harmful situations, both in the real world and the virtual world of computers and the internet, and a willingness to report these crimes when they occur. This is an effort in which we all must cooperate.

This report also illustrates the need for Idaho to continue dedicating law enforcement resources to address child sexual abuse. Because this problem is not going away, a commitment to properly training and equipping our law enforcement personnel and prosecutors is crucial. Our sheriffs, police officers and prosecutors need – and Idaho's children deserve – all the resources we can bring to bear on this issue.

IN FY16-FY17, 545 INCIDENTS OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE WERE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE, DIVISION OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES. I.C. § 67-1405(1).

Cases Filed:

A TOTAL OF 474 CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES WERE FILED (328 ADULT CASES, 146 JUVENILE PETITIONS) IN IDAHO DISTRICT AND JUVENILE COURTS IN FY17. THIS REPRESENTS AN INCREASE OF 15 CASES FILED SINCE FY16.

## **HISTORICAL OVERVIEW OF ANNUAL REPORT**

WITH THE PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL 362 IN 1989 (ADDING SECTION 67-1405 TO THE IDAHO CODE), THE DUTIES OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL WERE EXPANDED TO INCLUDE PREPARATION OF AN ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT REGARDING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE IN IDAHO. THE ANNUAL REPORTS PRESENTED TO THE IDAHO LEGISLATURE SINCE 1990 ARE AVAILABLE AT [www.ag.idaho.gov/publications/sexualabusereports.html](http://www.ag.idaho.gov/publications/sexualabusereports.html).

THE COLLECTION OF DATA AND PREPARATION OF THIS REPORT FOR FY17 IS THE RESULT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STAFF EFFORTS TO PREPARE A REPORT THAT COMPLIES WITH THE STATUTORY DIRECTIVES OF I.C. § 67-1405. THIS REPORT IS JOINTLY SUBMITTED BY GOVERNOR C. L. "BUTCH" OTTER AND ATTORNEY GENERAL LAWRENCE WARDEN.

## DATA COLLECTION PROCESS

THIS REPORT INCLUDES DATA ON “INCIDENTS” OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE IN FY17 (JULY 1, 2016 TO JUNE 30, 2017), THE ADULT AND JUVENILE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES FILED BY COUNTY PROSECUTORS IN FY17, THE DISPOSITIONS OF THE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES DURING THAT PERIOD, AND INFORMATION CONCERNING THE DISCHARGE OF INMATES WHO WERE CONVICTED OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CRIMES. THE PROCESS OF GATHERING INFORMATION INCLUDED IN THIS REPORT WAS INITIATED AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR IN JULY 2017.

IN KEEPING WITH THE INTENT OF I.C. § 67-1405, THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL COLLECTED DATA THROUGH SYSTEMS AND PROCESSES PRESENTLY UTILIZED BY THE CONTRIBUTING GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES. FOR EXAMPLE, INFORMATION CONCERNING THE REPORTING OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE INCIDENTS WAS GATHERED FROM “FACTS, FIGURES, TRENDS, 2016-2017: A REPORT PREPARED BY THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE.” FY17 CASE AND DISPOSITION INFORMATION WAS INITIALLY OBTAINED THROUGH THE SUPREME COURT’S STATEWIDE CASE MANAGEMENT DATABASE AND THEN PRESENTED TO EACH COUNTY PROSECUTOR’S OFFICE FOR REVIEW AND VERIFICATION. DISCHARGE AND PAROLE RELEASE DATA WAS COLLECTED FROM EXISTING COMMISSION OF PARDONS AND PAROLE DATA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017.

IN THIS REPORT, THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS ENDEAVORED TO COLLECT AND INCLUDE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE DATA PERTAINING TO: (1) INCIDENTS; (2) CASES; (3) DISPOSITIONS; AND (4) DISCHARGED INMATES AS REQUIRED BY I.C. § 67-1405. THIS REPORT INCLUDES CASES INVOLVING THE FOLLOWING STATUTORY SEXUAL OFFENSES INVOLVING CHILDREN:

- INJURY TO CHILDREN (I.C. § 18-1501);
- SEXUAL ABUSE OF A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS (I.C. § 18-1506);
- RITUALIZED ABUSE OF A CHILD (I.C. § 18-1506A);
- SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD (I.C. § 18-1507);
- POSSESSION OF SEXUALLY EXPLOITATIVE MATERIALS (I.C. § 18-1507A);
- LEWD CONDUCT WITH A MINOR CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN (I.C. § 18-1508);
- SEXUAL BATTERY OF A MINOR CHILD SIXTEEN OR SEVENTEEN YEARS OF AGE (I.C. § 18-1508A);
- ENTICING OF CHILDREN (I.C. § 18-1509); AND
- ENTICING OF CHILDREN OVER THE INTERNET (I.C. § 18-1509A).

CONSISTENT WITH THE STATUTORY MANDATE, THIS REPORT INCLUDES ONLY INFORMATION AVAILABLE THROUGH EXISTING SYSTEMS AND RESOURCES RELATING TO REPORTED INCIDENTS, CASES FILED, DISPOSITIONS, AND OFFENDERS DISCHARGED IN CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES INVOLVING THE ABOVE STATUTORY SECTIONS.

**REPORTED INCIDENTS**  
I.C. § 67-1405(1)

I.C. § 67-1405(1) PROVIDES:

THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE, EACH CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, EACH COUNTY SHERIFF AND THE IDAHO STATE POLICE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL A REPORT OF EACH CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE INCIDENT REPORTED TO EACH AGENCY OF STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT. THE REPORT SHALL CONTAIN SUCH INFORMATION AS SPECIFIED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO THE GREATEST EXTENT POSSIBLE TO USE AND DEVELOP THE INFORMATION REQUIRED IN THIS SECTION ON FORMS CURRENTLY IN USE BY EACH GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, THUS AVOIDING UNNECESSARY PAPERWORK.

IN THIS REPORT, THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS INCLUDED THE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE INCIDENT DATA REPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE<sup>1</sup> FOR FY06-FY17, WHICH IS SUMMARIZED AS FOLLOWS:

THE REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE DESIGNED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO MINIMIZE THE PAPERWORK IMPACT ON EACH COUNTY PROSECUTOR.


**A. SUMMARY OF ADULT CASES FILED**

ADULT OFFENDERS: CASES AND CHARGES FILED

INFORMATION ON THE ADULT CASES FILED IN FY17 IS INCLUDED IN **CHARTS A1 AND A2**. A TOTAL OF 328 ADULT CASES WERE FILED IN DISTRICT COURT DURING THE TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 2016 TO JUNE 30, 2017.


**CHART A1: MOST FREQUENTLY FILED CHARGES**



LEWD CONDUCT WITH A MINOR CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN (I.C. § 18-1508) CONTINUES TO BE THE CHARGE MOST FREQUENTLY FILED, REPRESENTING 40% OF THE CHARGES FILED IN THE 328 ADULT CASES.



JUVENILE OFFENDERS: PETITIONS FILED

ALL BUT 17 OF THE 146 JUVENILE PETITIONS REPORTED IN FY17 CHARGED LEWD CONDUCT WITH A MINOR CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN (I.C. §18-1508). THUS, LEWD CONDUCT WITH A MINOR CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN (I.C. §18-1508) IS CLEARLY THE PREDOMINANT CHARGE IN CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES WHERE THE OFFENDER IS A JUVENILE.

I.C. § 67-1405(3) PROVIDES:


THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL A REPORT SHOWING THE DISPOSITION OF EACH CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASE HANDLED BY EACH OF THE DISTRICT COURTS THROUGHOUT THE STATE. THIS REPORTING REQUIREMENT MAY BE SATISFIED BY SUBMISSION OF A COPY OF A JUDGMENT MADE AND ENTERED IN EACH CASE.

**A. SUMMARY OF DISPOSITIONS FOR ADULT CASES FILED IN FY17**

ADULT OFFENDERS: DISPOSITION INFORMATION

**CHART A3** SHOWS THAT IN FY17, CONVICTIONS WERE OBTAINED IN 119 CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES WHERE THE OFFENDER WAS AN ADULT; DISMISSALS WERE ENTERED IN 23 CASES AND 185 CASES REMAIN PENDING.

**CHART A3: SENTENCING DISPOSITIONS**




**CHART A3** ALSO SHOWS THAT OF THOSE CONVICTED IN FY17, 59 ADULTS (39%) WERE SENTENCED TO PRISON; 30 ADULTS (20%) WERE GIVEN RETAINED JURISDICTION; AND 61 ADULTS (41%) WERE PLACED ON PROBATION.

**B. SUMMARY OF DISPOSITION INFORMATION FOR JUVENILE OFFENDERS**

JUVENILE OFFENDERS: DISPOSITION INFORMATION

**CHART J2** SHOWS THAT OF THE 58 JUVENILES DISPOSITIONED IN FY17 IN CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CASES, PROBATION WAS GRANTED IN 49 CASES (84%), AND 9 JUVENILES (16%) WERE COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE CORRECTIONS.

**DISCHARGED OFFENDERS**  
I.C. § 67-1405(4)

I.C. § 67-1405(4) PROVIDES:

THE COMMISSION ON PARDONS AND PAROLE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL A REPORT SHOWING THE RELEASE OR DISCHARGE OF ANY INDIVIDUAL CONVICTED OF A CRIME INVOLVING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE. SUCH REPORT SHALL BE DESIGNED TO MINIMIZE THE PAPERWORK IMPACT UPON THE COMMISSION.

THE COMMISSION OF PARDONS AND PAROLE REPORTED THAT DURING THE 2017 FISCAL YEAR, IT GRANTED PAROLE TO 36 INMATES AND DISCHARGED AN ADDITIONAL 175 INMATES WHO HAD COMPLETED THEIR SENTENCES. THESE INMATES WERE OFFENDERS SERVING SENTENCES FOR COMMITTING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE CRIMES. (SEE TABLE 4 FOR MORE INFORMATION).
