Internship Information

The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) is seeking second year law students for the 2022 summer internship program. Summer internships will run for a 10-week period from mid-May to the end of July/beginning of August. Interns will receive a daily rate of compensation and have the opportunity to participate in summer educational and community programs through the OAG.

Interns will work directly with Deputy Attorneys General on substantive legal matters. Projects may include researching and writing memorandums, legal briefs, motions, and interrogatories, assisting with preparation for trial, witness interviews, document organization, and other tasks as assigned by a supervisor.
