## **Internship Information**

The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) is seeking first and second-year law students for the 2024 summer internship program. Summer internships will run for ten weeks, from May 28 to August 2. Interns will be hired as temporary, non-benefitted employees and will receive an hourly rate of pay of \$20.00. They will have the opportunity to participate in summer educational and community programs through the OAG.

Interns will work directly with deputy attorneys general and deputy solicitors general on substantive legal matters. Projects may include researching and writing memorandums, legal briefs, motions, and interrogatories, assisting with preparation for trial, witness interviews, document organization, and other tasks as assigned by a supervisor.

## **Externship Information**

The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) accepts applications from first, second, and third-year law students for externships for fall and spring semesters in many of its divisions. Externs may be eligible for academic credit.

Externs work directly with deputy attorneys general and deputy solicitors general on substantive legal matters. Projects may include researching and writing memorandums, legal briefs, motions, and interrogatories, assisting with preparation for trial, witness interviews, document organization, and other tasks as assigned by a supervisor.
