A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMMON, IDAHO DECLARING RECEIPT AND EXPENSE ACCOUNT OF STATE FUNDING IN CONNECTION WITH THE NATIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Ammon was entitled certain funds from the national opioid settlement fund, based on the population and demographic characteristics of the City of Ammon; and

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho placed restrictions on how the funds could be spent and which expenses would qualify for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ammon followed directions from the State of Idaho and utilized the national opioid settlement funds for approved purposes; and

WHEREAS, this resolution provides an accounting of the funds received and spent by the City of Ammon from the national opioid settlement fund; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of this resolution shall be September 7, 2023; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of Ammon, Idaho that the City Council hereby adopts the following sections as public policy:

Section 1. Receipt of Funding.

- 1. During the State of Idaho's Fiscal Year 2022, the City of Ammon received \$1,218.78 in opioid settlement funds.
- 2. During the State of Idaho's Fiscal Year 2023, the City of Ammon received \$6,445.40 in opioid settlement funds.

Section 2. Expense of Funds.

- 1. During the State of Idaho's Fiscal Year 2023, the City of Ammon spent \$7,419.45 on approved expenses as shown in Exhibit A Approved Opioid Abatement Strategies. We spent all funds in Section G Prevent Misuse of Opioids. Subsection 4 Drug take-back disposal or destructions programs the City spent \$3,119.45. Subsection 9 School-based or youth-focused programs or strategies that have demonstrated effectiveness in preventing drug misuse and seem likely to be effective in preventing the uptake and use of opioids the City spent \$4,300.
- 2. During the State of Idaho's Fiscal Year 2024, the City of Ammon plans on spending the remaining \$244.73 on Section G, subsection 9 again, to support the local DARE program.
- 3. For any future dispersals of funding, the City of Ammon has reallocated these directly to District 7, Eastern Idaho Public Health.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon the day of its adoption.
