Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of my client, the City of Sun Valley (the “City”). On March 20, 2024, the City discovered suspicious activity related to an employee email account. The City immediately began an investigation with the assistance of legal counsel and a nationally-recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm. Through the investigation, the City found that an employee email account was subject to unauthorized access and that unauthorized acquisition of the contents of that mailbox could not be ruled out. Working with its investigators, the City reviewed the data contained within the employee email account to determine if it contained any personally identifiable information (“PII”). On Monday, April 1, 2024, the City discovered that this incident involved unauthorized acquisition of personal information, as defined by Idaho law. The City is continuing to work with legal counsel and its digital forensics firm to investigate the scope of the incident and notify impacted individuals.

The City is also notifying the ITS Chief Information Officer of this incident. The City will continue to investigate and will be providing written notice to the identified impacted individuals, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring as soon as possible. We will keep you informed of any significant developments as the investigation continues.
