Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of our clients, North Star Charter School, Wilder School District #133 and Filer School District #413 (collectively, the “Schools”). On or about January 7, 2025, the Schools received notification from their third-party vendor, PowerSchool, regarding a cybersecurity incident that impacted their data maintained in PowerSchool. PowerSchool provides Student Information Systems to the Schools, which is used to manage education information related to students and staff. Upon learning about this incident, the Schools began an investigation with the assistance of legal counsel and a nationally recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm. On February 4, 2025, the cyber security firm working with the Schools’ staffs confirmed to the Schools that the data affected by the PowerSchool incident included personal information as defined in Idaho Code § 28-51-104(5). The personal information affected included Idaho residents’ names and Social Security numbers. Therefore, the Schools are reporting a breach of the security of the system, pursuant to Idaho Code § 28-51-105(1), resulting from the cybersecurity incident impacting PowerSchool.

PowerSchool has begun notification to impacted individuals on behalf of the Schools, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring. We will keep you informed of any significant developments as the investigation continues.
