The Allumbaugh House provides short-term, medically monitored detoxification and mental health crisis services in Boise. In FYs 2024-2026 (and a portion of FY 2027), the city plans to support Allumbaugh House by using a portion of its opioid legal settlement funds. The city maintains a share of these settlement funds, paid by opioid manufacturers and certain pharmacies, in a reserve account. In FY 2024, the city will transfer \$318,417 from the reserve account to Contractual Services, which is where the city budgets for its Allumbaugh House expenses. Using the opioid settlement funds for Allumbaugh House will create temporary capacity in the General Fund (which has historically supported this cost) to fund other community-focused items, such as housing, transportation, and public safety.
