Attached please find a spreadsheet showing the allocation for an upcoming opioid settlement payment from the NOAT II Trust (see Attachment A, Annex 2. NOAT II Funding Cycle 2). The NOAT II Trust was established to distribute funds from bankruptcy proceedings involving the settlement of opioid claims. This upcoming payment is made from the Mallinckrodt second bankruptcy and is the final Mallinckrodt payment.
