Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of my client, Elmore County (the “County”). On April 15, 2025, The County discovered that an unknown actor had accessed a County email account without authorization. The County immediately began working with legal counsel and a nationally recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm to investigate the scope of the incident and mitigate any resulting harm.

The County is working with legal counsel and the digital forensics firm to identify and review the impacted data to determine what specific information may have been affected, and to whom that information relates, so that it can comply with any notification obligations. On May 5, 2025, as part of its ongoing investigation, the County determined that this incident involved unauthorized acquisition of personal information, as defined by Idaho law. The County will be providing written notice to affected individuals, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring where appropriate.

The County also notified the ITS Chief Information Security Officer of this incident. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
