Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of Teton County, Idaho (the “County”). Recently, the County learned that the driver’s license number of one (1) Idaho resident was inadvertently left unredacted in a response by the County to a public records request. Upon learning this, the County conducted an investigation and engaged external legal counsel to determine the scope of the incident. In response to this incident, the County counseled the employee responsible for providing responses to public records requests regarding privacy practices and the importance of redacting personal information and is reviewing the County public records request form to remove areas where confidential personal information can be included.

On January 27, 2026, the County provided written notice to the affected individual via U.S. mail which included an offer of complimentary credit monitoring.
