Formal Notice of Unauthorized Disclosure of Protected Information / Data Breach **CONSUMER PROTECTION DIVISION**

I am writing to formally report a significant breach of privacy and a violation of data security protocols involving the Lemhi County Prosecuting Attorney's Office.

Description of Incident:

On September 30th 2025 I received a digital discovery file/folder through my attorney, John Malek, as part of the discovery process case # CR30-25-520 & case # CR30-25-413 Upon reviewing the contents, I discovered that the Prosecuting Attorney's Office included highly sensitive, private files belonging to a third party (a stranger) who is not involved in my case.

Nature of Violation:

A Violation of Idaho Code 28-51-105: The improper disclosure of personal information by a state/county agency.

A Breach of Confidentiality: Violating the privacy rights of the third party and compromising the security of the discovery process in my own case.

This error demonstrates a gross lack of competence and a failure to safeguard sensitive information. Furthermore, this "commingling" of files raises serious concerns about the integrity of the evidence being used against me. If the Prosecutor is unable to distinguish between my files and a stranger's files, the reliability of their entire investigation is compromised.

I find that due to the manner in which my case has not been properly documented or investigated. That the possibility of adding these files to my case, to aid in building a more believable argument against me for the prosecution, is highly possible. Especially do to the similarities of charges and the timing of when these files were added. Coming only days after I was charged of the same crime, and 45 days after the initial incident took place.
