Re: Notice of Potential Data Exposure

On March 13, 2026, an Idaho Department of Labor (Department) employee inadvertently emailed a claimant's name, phone number, driver's license number, and social security number to a non-interested individual. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 28-51-105, the Department informed the claimant that same day that their personal information had been compromised. The non-interested individual was also notified of the inadvertent disclosure and asked to delete the claimant's information.

The Department provided the claimant with information on credit monitoring and provided the telephone number of a contact at the Department to call if they have any questions.
