Re: Cybersecurity Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

The Idaho State Insurance Fund is writing to notify your office of a cybersecurity incident.

We have completed an investigation of suspicious activity associated with a single employee's email account. Upon learning of the activity, we immediately took steps to secure the account and began our investigation. The investigation determined that an unauthorized person accessed the email account between April 20, 2026, and April 23, 2026. We reviewed the emails and attachments that were accessed and determined that they contained the name, address, and Social Security numbers of 42 Idaho residents.

By May 21, 2026, we mailed notification letters to the Idaho residents via United States First-Class mail. We offered the residents one year of complimentary credit monitoring, fraud consultation and identity theft restoration services through Epiq. We also provided a telephone number to the Idaho residents that they can call with any questions.

We have multi-factor authentication in place for email, but the employee involved authorized the second factor. We will continue to provide training to our employees on social engineering tactics.
